

SIMPLY BALLET SPORTS VOUCHERS



Simply Ballet is a registered organisation with the SA Government Sports Voucher Program.

The Sports Vouchers Program is a Government of South Australia initiative administered by the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing. The program provides an opportunity for children from Reception to Year 9 to receive up to 2x \$100 discount on their dance fees and uniforms.

For 2026 this means eligible children will have a year of birth from 2011 to 2021.

The Sports Vouchers program does come with some pre-requisites and requirements. We've done our best to detail everything in this policy. If you are unsure, please contact Simply Ballet or the Sports Voucher Program.

Child Eligibility

- Your child is aged 5 or is becoming 5 in the calendar year the subsidy is being claimed for and is still eligible to attend primary school. This means Reception to Year 9 (inclusive);
- Your child resides in South Australia;
- Each eligible child can access 2x \$100 vouchers for the 2026 calendar year. However, you may choose to use two vouchers between different providers (such as Swimming and Ballet). You will need to advise Simply Ballet how many vouchers you are claiming for when you send through your application form.
- If you have already used the 2x \$100 vouchers through other providers (such as swim lessons) you cannot apply through Simply Ballet as well. Your application will be subject to the Sports Voucher Program assessing your claim;
- Your child is required to participate in Simply Ballet classes for a minimum of 8 weeks (excluding any trial classes taken). For example, you must be enrolled on a term invoice for your claim to become valid.

How it Works

1. You enrol your eligible child into a full term of classes (a minimum of 8 weeks);
2. Advise Simply Ballet if you are claiming ONE (\$100) or TWO (2x \$100) vouchers;
3. To claim your subsidy, you must submit your Sports Voucher directly to Simply Ballet using the Sports Voucher shown below within 7 days of your enrolment. The critical section of information is your Medicare number or your Australian Visa number. You can send the voucher in to the studio with your child or email it directly to office@simplyballet.com.au;
4. If your claim is approved by the Sports Vouchers team, your invoice will then be generated with a credit of up to \$200. If your claim is not approved, you shall be required to pay the full term fees of your invoice;
5. You will then be required to pay the balance of your invoice in full by the due date.

Other Things You Need to Know

1. This program is run by the Government of South Australia and therefore they have the right to terminate this program at any time. If this occurs Simply Ballet will advise you.
2. The Sports Vouchers Program team may contact you directly from time to time to discuss your application or with random audits/surveys, date of birth or eligibility issues. Should your claim not be successful Simply Ballet will request full payment of any monies owing from the parent/guardian.
3. You must give consent to sharing your information with the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing.
4. The claim cannot be used for the sole purpose of reimbursement of uniforms, equipment or for one-off activities. Therefore it cannot be used solely for concert participation, costumes, exam fees or workshops.
5. What if my fees are less than the total voucher?

If the total of the fees are less than the voucher amount, then this is the maximum that can be claimed. For example if your fees are \$80 then the most you can claim is \$80 (on a \$100 voucher) and you will forgo the remaining \$20 of the voucher. However, uniforms or other equipment purchased through Simply Ballet can be included on your invoice to be claimed against the voucher.
