From July 2021, Simply Ballet is a registered organisation with the SA Government Sports Voucher Program.

The Sports Vouchers Program is a Government of South Australia initiative administered by the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing. The program provides an opportunity for primary school aged children from Reception to Year 7 to receive up to a \$100 discount on their dance fees and uniforms.

For the remainder of 2021, the current eligibility will continue - primary school aged children from Reception to Year 7 (even if Year 7 is based at a high school). For 2021 this means eligible children will have a year of birth from 2008 to 2016. The Government recently announced the expansion of Sports Vouches to students in Years 8 and 9. This will commence from 1 January 2022.

The Sports Vouchers program does come with some pre-requisites and requirements. We've done our best to detail everything in this policy. If you are unsure, please contact Simply Ballet or the Sports Voucher Program.

Child Eligibility

- Your child is aged 5 or is becoming 5 in the calendar year the subsidy is being claimed for and is still eligible to attend primary school. This means Reception to Year 7 (inclusive), even if the school that the child attends has Year 7 in middle or secondary school;
- Your child resides in South Australia;
- You can only apply for the subsidy once per calendar year per child. This means if you have already made a claim through another provider (such as swim lessons) you cannot apply through Simply Ballet as well. Your application is subject to the Sports Voucher Program assessing your claim;
- Your child is required to participate in Simply Ballet activities for 8 weeks or more. For example, you must be enrolled on a term invoice for your claim to become valid.

How it Works

1. You enrol your eligible child into a full term of classes (a minimum 8 weeks);
2. To claim your subsidy, you must submit your Sports Voucher directly to Simply Ballet using the Sports Voucher shown below within 7 days of your enrolment. The critical section of information is your Medicare number or your Australian Visa number. You can send the voucher in to the studio with your child or email it directly to office@simplyballet.com.au;
3. If your claim is approved by the Sports Vouchers team, your invoice will then be generated with a credit of up to \$100. If your claim is not approved, you shall be required to pay the full term fees of your invoice;
4. You will then be required to pay the balance of your invoice in full by the due date.

What if my fees are less than \$100?


If the total of the fees are less than the voucher amount, then this is the maximum that can be claimed. For example if your fees are \$80 then the most you can claim is \$80 and you will forgo the remaining \$20 of the voucher. However, uniforms or other equipment purchased through Simply Ballet can be included on your invoice to be claimed against the voucher.

Other Things You Need to Know

1. This program is run by the Government of South Australia and therefore they have the right to terminate this program at any time. If this occurs Simply Ballet will advise you.
2. The Sports Vouchers Program team may contact you directly from time to time to discuss your application or with random audits/surveys, date of birth or eligibility issues. Should your claim not be successful Simply Ballet will request full payment of any monies owing from the parent/guardian.
3. You must give consent to sharing your information with the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing.
4. The claim cannot be used for the sole purpose of reimbursement of uniforms, equipment or for one-off activities. Therefore it cannot be used for concert participation, costumes, exam fees or workshops.
5.
